At a special April 22, 2020 meeting, the Ethics Board (the "Board") approved your Application dated April 17, 2020 to solicit sponsors in support of the above-referenced solicitation campaign. This approval is subject to the following conditions:

1. *In general*. The campaign must be conducted in accordance with the standards, terms, and conditions set forth in Board Regulation 06.26.1 and your Application.

## 2. Reports.

- i. A Final Report (due within 30 days after all solicitations and receipt of all anticipated donations) must be filed with the Ethics Board on Ethics Form 627.
- ii. Based on your application's stated aggregated value of donations being sought {"between \$50,000 and \$150,000"} and other factors, an Interim Report will be due once every 3 months from **April 1**, **2020**.
- 3. *Expiration*. This approval expires on April 30, 2021, as indicated on your Application. After that date, a new Application will be required for any further solicitation efforts. **NOTE: A new Application for additional** solicitation efforts cannot be considered complete and cannot be approved unless all Reports then due under this approval have been completed and filed with the Ethics Board.
