## Minutes of the Meeting

The Ethics Board met on May 11, 2022 at 2:30 pm by conference call.

**Call to Order:** Chairman Stephan Fogleman called the Ethics Board meeting to order at 2:37 pm with a quorum present.

Statement Concerning April's Administrative Session and Potential Administrative Session: Chair Fogleman read the following statement:

Per the Open Meetings Act, the Board discloses that it adjourned its virtual open meeting on April 13, 2022 to enter into an administrative session at approximately 2:50 pm. All Board members were present. Members discussed administrative matters including complaints.

The Board may need to close some or all of this meeting to preserve the confidentiality mandated by the Ethics Code or as otherwise authorized by the State Open Meetings Act. Likewise, upon adjournment of the Open Session, the Board may reconvene for an Administrative Session to discuss non-public, administrative functions of the Board.

Governmental/Charitable Solicitation Waiver Application – Office of Council President Annual Holiday Toy Drive: General Counsel for City Council, Aaron DeGraffenreidt, provided an overview of the solicitation waiver application. Vice Chair Davis inquired about the previous Holiday Toy Drive campaign's final report. Director Hochstetler confirmed receipt of the past campaign's final report and stated that the Movement Team, Inc., would again serve as the new campaign's fiscal sponsor. The Board approved the waiver with a vote of 4-0.

**Approval of Written Minutes for April 13, 2022 Public Meeting:** Executive Assistant Ford corrected the number of March help desk requests presented at the April 13, 2022 Public Meeting. The Board approved the amended April 13, 2022 minutes with a vote of 4-0.

**Director's Update:** Director Hochstetler and Executive Assistant Ford updated the Board on the staff's recent work:

  - April 32 people enrolled in training (pending report from Department of Human Resources)
    - April 20, 2022 23 DGS supervisors attended live training
  - o May (230 people enrolled)
  - o June (42 people registered so far)
  - o July (20 people registered so far)
  - August (2 people registered so far)

- o Total FY22 attendees: 697
- O Director Hochstetler explained that the Department of Human Resources would not provide the Ethics Training on the City's virtual learning platform in June and July since the training is merging to a new platform, Workday. Hochstetler stated that Ethics Board staff will provide the training on the Ethics Board's website.
