Finally, he reported on the promulgation of the Financial Disclosure bill (19-0457) and requested if the Board had a position on the Financial Disclosure bill. By a vote of 3-0, the Board instructed staff to draft a letter taking a neutral position on the matter and expressing concern regarding the reporting thresholds.
