ACTION REQUESTED OF THE BOARD OF ESTIMATES:

The Board is requested to endorse a Governmental/Charitable Solicitation Application for submission to the Board of Ethics of Baltimore City to allow MOCFS' Executive Director, Tisha Edwards, to solicit donations from local individuals, businesses, civic leaders, the foundation community and the general public to support College Signing Day.

AMOUNT AND SOURCE OF FUNDS:

No general funds are involved in this transaction.

BACKGROUND/EXPLANATION:

Donations will be solicited from Baltimore businesses, civic leaders, the foundation community and the general population. A potential donor list will be comprised of individuals and corporate entities that contribute to the economic, social, and cultural vitality of Baltimore City. Most of the individual and corporate entities fitting that description are not controlled donors. However, those potential donors who are controlled donors with respect to the City Council or the Board of Estimates will not be targeted or singled out in any way and will be solicited, if at all, in the same manner as the other potential donors from February 12, 2020 through December 31, 2020. College Signing Day is an annual celebration event of young people being accepted into college in the same manner that we celebrate athletes being drafted into a professional league.

Baltimore City Code, Article 8, §6-26 prohibits solicitation or facilitating the solicitation of a gift. An exception was enacted in 2005 to permit certain solicitations that are for the benefit of an official governmental program or activity, or a City-endorsed charitable function or activity. Ethics regulation 96.26B sets out the standards for approval, which includes the requirement that the program, function, or activity to benefit from the proposed solicitation must be endorsed by the Board of Estimates or its designee.
